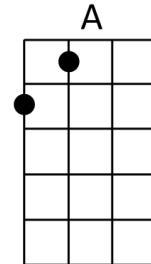


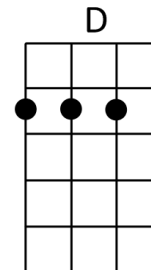


I Hope That I Don't Fall In Love With You by Tom Waits

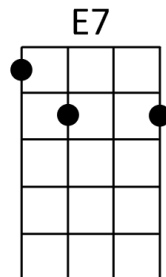
A D E7
